Special Issue: NO on the Newsom Recall

Upcoming Recall Election—VOTE NO!—Call your fellow Democrats!

The recall election, a right-wing Republican attempt to unseat Governor Gavin Newsom, is right around the corner. In the California Democratic Party (CADEM) document on Page 2, you'll find important, detailed information on this special election.

THE MOST IMPORTANT THINGS TO KNOW ARE:

- **Vote NO on QUESTION #1.**
- **Do NOT Vote on QUESTION #2.**
- **CAREFULLY Sign, Date and Seal Your Ballot.**
- **IF you are mailing your ballot, NO Stamp is needed.**

The election is on **Tuesday, September 14**. You should receive your ballot soon after August 16.

Siskiyou Democrats recommend that you get your ballot in the mail as early as possible, so we'll show strong NO results on election night.

Here's **what you can do** before the election to stop this cynical recall, and help Get Out the Vote:

1. **Vote NO** on Question #1 on your ballot.
2. **Forward this information** to your friends and family and encourage them to vote NO on Question #1 on their ballot.
3. **Make phone calls** to Siskiyou Democrats encouraging our neighbors to vote NO in the special recall election. To join this effort, first attend one of our Siskiyou training meetings:

AUGUST 16

Every active registered voter will be mailed a vote-by-mail ballot for the recall election. Counties will begin to mail vote-by-mail ballots approximately 29 days before the Election Day.

SEPTEMBER 14

Election Day: Vote **NO on the Recall**

HOW YOUR VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT WORKS

All registered voters in California will be mailed a ballot approximately 29 days before the Election on **Tuesday, September 14.**

- Fill out your ballot by voting **NO on the recall**, insert it into the return envelop and seal it.
- Complete ALL required information on the back of the return envelope, including your **SIGNATURE** and **DATE**.
- Return your ballot by **mail** (no stamp needed), or at any **Drop Box, Vote Center, County Elections Office or Polling Place**.

BY U.S. MAIL

Must be postmarked by Tuesday, September 14

Mail your ballot at any U.S. Postal Service mailbox or post office (if mailed on Election Day, make sure another collection is scheduled).

No stamp is needed. Do not mail your ballot after September 14.
